Entries must be made by centres between 01 March and 04 May 2023. No entries will be accepted after 4PM AEST on 04 May 2023.

This registration form should NOT be returned to Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing but should be handed to your test centre.

All entries must be made by registered centres via the Cambridge Assessment Admissions Testing Entries Extranet.

Centre Examinations Officers wishing to make changes to an entry should NOT make a new entry, as this may cause a delay in the processing of results. Instead the existing entry should be edited.
